For those of you who are attending this year I will be handing out the tickets next week, Tuesday 30th September and Thursday 2nd October respectively. Unfortunately, the 9th October is a Thursday and will therefore mean that I cannot run a class that evening. I apologize for any inconvenience caused.

Next Year - 2009

If you are interested in joining us next year you are of course more than welcome. However, tickets do go like hot cakes which means I have to purchase them a year in advance (10th October 2008).
