International Championships Royal Albert Hall 21st October 2010

Where, from the comfort of your box you will see the world's finest competitive dancers in both amateur and professional status in Ballroom and Latin styles, battling it out for the 2010 titles. This year we have purchased ten 2nd tier boxes, each containing five seats per box.

The seat prices are £30 each or you can purchase the whole box for £150; seat allocation being on a first come first served basis.



I will be confirming with those individuals who have already expressed their interest in joining us, if they still require tickets, before I allocate the remainder. I would also ask that full payment be made within one month of tickets being issued.

If at a later date you find that you cannot attend the competition, unfortunately, we will not be in a position to refund any monies, but we will make every effort to sell the tickets on, on your behalf.
